How can FIN support Peers as Partners in Learning (PPL)?

The PPL program can be adapted to match your school's needs based on data, scheduling, programs, and resources. FIN facilitators are available to support your school as your program grows.

Your FIN will:

- Offer to assist with Inclusive Scheduling to make sure the PPL course fits seamlessly into your master schedule.
- Offer an overview of the PPL program to help your faculty or other stakeholders understand the purpose, benefits, and processes for starting a PPL program.
- Assist your PPL team with developing a timeline and tasks to be accomplished.
- Provide marketing materials and assistance that can be disseminated to staff, students, and families.
- Provide resources and ideas to get your program going.
- Provide technical assistance to the team and the ESE teacher of record.
- Follow up with quarterly contact to the ESE teacher of record.
- Conduct an annual needs assessment to determine any needed adjustments.
- Assist with ways to collect and analyze implementation data.
